This year, the DLG Field Days will take place in Kirschgartshausen near Mannheim from June 14 to 16, 2022

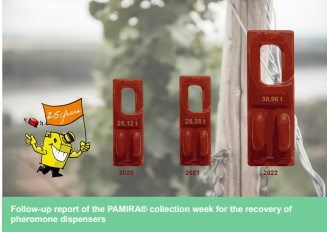

Follow-up report of the PAMIRA® collection week for the recovery of pheromone dispensers
